

Gurdwara Janam Asthan, Nankana Sahib

Nankana Sahib, the birthplace of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, hosts several historic gurdwaras. Gurdwara Janam Asthan marks his birth, Patti Sahib where he learned the alphabet, and Malji Sahib where he meditated. Bal Lila Sahib reflects his childhood, while Kiara Sahib and Tambu Sahib commemorate his miracles and travels. Chhatti Patshahi marks the visit of Guru Hargobind Sahib. These gurdwaras together honor key moments of Guru Nanak's early life.



Gurdwara Sacha Sauda, Farooqabad

Gurdwara Sacha Sauda, located in Farooqabad near Lahore, is a key stop on Sikh heritage tours in Pakistan. It marks the site where Guru Nanak Dev Ji performed his "True Bargain" by feeding the needy instead of trading goods. Surrounded by peaceful gardens and a sacred sarovar, it offers pilgrims and tourists a powerful message of compassion and selfless service.



Gurdwara Darbar Sahib, Kartarpur

Gurdwara Darbar Sahib Kartarpur is a sacred site where Guru Nanak Dev Ji spent his final years. For Sikh pilgrims with **JAIYANA** *Travel*, it offers a peaceful and spiritual experience, connecting them deeply with the Guru's teachings at this holy place near the Ravi River.



Gurdwara Panja Sahib

Gurdwara Dera Sahib

Gurdwara Janam Asthan Guru Ram Das Ji

Gurdwara Janam Asthan Guru Ram Das Ji, located in Lahore's Walled City, marks the birthplace of the fourth Sikh Guru. Built during Maharaja Ranjit Singh's era, it is a serene and historic site where Guru Ram Das Ji spent his early years. 

Lahore

The city reflects the grandeur of Sikh rule and remains a central place of pilgrimage and historical interest for Sikhs worldwide.


Gujranwala

Gujranwala is the birthplace of Maharaja Ranjit Singh, the founder of the Sikh Empire. His ancestral haveli still stands as a historic symbol, though in poor condition. The city also houses the samadhis of Mahan Singh and Charat Singh in Sheranwala Bagh.

Nearby, Gurdwara Rori Sahib in Eminabad marks Guru Nanak Dev Ji's visit and remains an important pilgrimage site. Gujranwala played a key role in the rise of Sikh power, with many Sikh leaders emerging from the region.


Sialkot

Sialkot is home to key Sikh heritage sites, including Gurdwara Babe di Beri, where Guru Nanak Dev Ji met Sufi saint Hamza Ghaus under a sacred berry tree, and Gurdwara Baoli Sahib, linked to Bhai Maula Karar's story. These gurdwaras reflect interfaith harmony and are being revived for Sikh pilgrims today.



Jhelum

Jhelum is home to Gurdwara Chowa Sahib, where Guru Nanak Dev Ji created a water spring for Bhai Mardana near Rohtas Fort. Nearby, Tilla Jogian marks the site where Guru Nanak meditated for 40 days and held spiritual dialogue with yogis. Both sites reflect his message of peace and interfaith harmony.



Rawalpindi

Rawalpindi has a rich Sikh heritage with historic sites like Gurdwara Singh Sabha, Gurdwara Bagh Sardaran, and the iconic Haveli Sujan Singh a grand 19th-century mansion built by Rai Bahadur Sujan Singh. These landmarks reflect the city's vibrant Sikh past and are now part of heritage restoration efforts.



Kallar Sayda & Thoa Khalsa

Thoha Khalsa and Kallar Syedan, once vibrant Sikh villages near Rawalpindi, were home to several Gurdwaras and Sikh communities before 1947. Thoha Khalsa is remembered for its tragic partition history, while both villages still hold remnants of Sikh heritage that reflect their spiritual and cultural past — including the Bedi Mahal, a grand haveli built by Baba Khem Singh Bedi, a direct descendant of Guru Nanak Dev Ji.



Kasur


Kasur holds historical importance in Sikh heritage. It is home to Gurdwara Panchvin Patshahi, marking the visit of Guru Hargobind Sahib Ji. The area is also associated with Bhai Mani Singh, a revered Sikh martyr born nearby. Though few structures remain, Kasur's link to early Sikh history makes it a site of spiritual significance.






Maharaja Ranjit Singh Trail

Maharaja Ranjit Singh, the Lion of Punjab, was a great ruler and patron of Sikh heritage. He restored and built key gurdwaras across present-day Pakistan, including Gurdwara Janam Asthan (Nankana Sahib), Gurdwara Panja Sahib (Hasan Abdal), Gurdwara Dera Sahib (Lahore), and supported Gurdwara Darbar Sahib (Kartarpur). He also built Gurdwara Rori Sahib (Eminabad) and contributed to Gurdwara Chowah Sahib (Jhelum). His samadhi in Lahore stands as a symbol of his devotion. Cities like Lahore, Nankana Sahib, Kartarpur, and Jhelum reflect his lasting legacy in Sikh history.



Hari Singh Nalwa Trail

Hari Singh Nalwa, the famed general of Maharaja Ranjit Singh, left a lasting mark across northwest Pakistan. He built Jamrud Fort, founded Haripur, and governed Peshawar, securing Sikh rule on the Afghan frontier. His trail highlights Sikh bravery, strategic vision, and architectural legacy in the region.




