

Sindh Temples





Shiv Mandir, Clifton

Located near Clifton Beach in Karachi, Shiv Mandir is one of the city's oldest Hindu temples. Dedicated to Lord Shiva, it is a vibrant center of worship, especially during Maha Shivratri. The temple symbolizes religious harmony and serves as a spiritual refuge in the heart of the city.

Panchmukhi Hanuman Mandir

Located in Soldier Bazaar, Karachi, the Panchmukhi Hanuman Mandir is believed to be around 1,500 years old, making it one of the oldest Hindu temples in Pakistan. It houses a rare self-manifested, five-faced idol of Hanuman, not found anywhere else in the world. The temple is a vital spiritual center for the Hindu community and becomes especially vibrant during Hanuman Jayanti.



Shri Swaminarayan Mandir

Located on M.A. Jinnah Road, Shri Swaminarayan Mandir is the only Swaminarayan temple in Pakistan. Built in the early 19th century, it serves as a major spiritual and cultural center for Karachi's Hindu community. The temple hosts key festivals like Diwali and Holi and is known for its large complex, sacred cowshed, and historical significance during the 1947 partition.

Shri Laxmi Narayan Mandir

Located under the Native Jetty Bridge, this 200-year-old temple is dedicated to Goddess Lakshmi and Lord Vishnu. It is the only Hindu temple in Karachi with direct access to seawater, making it vital for rituals like cremation and Ganesh immersion. Despite threats from nearby development, it remains an active and important spiritual site for the Hindu community.



Ramapir Mandir

Built in 1861, Ramapir Mandir is dedicated to Ramdev Pir, a saint revered by Hindus in Sindh. It is one of Pakistan's most important Hindu pilgrimage sites. Every year, thousands attend the Ramapir Mela, bringing flags and singing bhajans in devotion. The temple symbolizes spiritual unity and is open to devotees year-round.



Shiv Mandir, Phuleli

Shiv Mandir, Phuleli is a small, active Hindu temple located near the Phuleli canal in Hyderabad, Sindh. It serves the local Hindu community and becomes especially lively during festivals like Maha Shivratri. Though not a major pilgrimage site, it holds religious and cultural significance for nearby residents.


Kalka Cave Temple

Kalka Cave Temple is an ancient Hindu shrine near Rohri, Sukkur, built inside a natural cave. Dedicated to Goddess Kali, it's believed to be on her route to Hinglaj. The temple is visited by both Hindus and Muslims, especially during Navratri and the first Monday of each month. It reflects deep interfaith harmony and is a unique spiritual site in Sindh.



Jhulelal Mandir

Jhulelal Mandir Karachi, also known as Darya Lal Mandir, is a 300-year-old Hindu temple located near the Custom House in Saddar. Dedicated to Jhulelal, the Sindhi water deity, it symbolizes interfaith harmony. The temple was restored in 2015 and is especially active during Cheti Chand, the Sindhi New Year festival.



Sadhu Bela Mandir

Sadhu Bela Mandir is a historic Hindu temple located on an island in the Indus River near Sukkur, Sindh. Founded in 1823 by Baba Bankhandi Maharaj, it is a sacred site for Hindus and Udasi Sikhs. The complex has multiple temples, a library, and gardens. Accessible only by boat, it hosts an annual festival in memory of its founder and remains a symbol of spiritual harmony in Sindh.

Odero Lal Temple Complex

Odero Lal Temple Complex in Sindh, Pakistan, is a rare shared sacred site where Hindus worship Jhulelal and Muslims revere Sheikh Tahir. The complex houses both a Hindu temple and a Muslim shrine, symbolizing centuries of interfaith harmony along the Indus River.

Shri Shiv Mandir

Shri Shiv Mandir is a Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Shiva, located in various parts of Sindh, Pakistan — one notable one being in Clifton, Karachi. These temples are significant spiritual sites for the Hindu community and often feature traditional Shiva lingams for worship. Many Shiv Mandirs in Sindh are centuries old, showcasing rich architectural and cultural heritage.

Katas Raj Temples

Katas Raj is a sacred Hindu temple complex in Chakwal, Punjab, dedicated to Lord Shiva. It features ancient temples and a holy pond believed to be formed from Shiva's tears. The site is linked to the Mahabharata and is one of the most important Hindu pilgrimage spots in Pakistan, especially during Shivratri.



Krishna Mandir Lahore

Located on Ravi Road, Krishna Mandir is one of the few functional Hindu temples in Lahore. Dedicated to Lord Krishna, it hosts major Hindu festivals like Diwali and Holi. Managed by the Pakistan Hindu Council and Evacuee Trust, it serves the small but active Hindu community in the city.



Balmik Mandir Lahore

Located in Neela Gumbad near Anarkali, Balmik Mandir is one of the few functional Hindu temples in Lahore. Dedicated to Sage Valmiki, it serves the small Valmiki Hindu community and holds regular prayers, especially on Tuesdays. The temple was reclaimed and reopened to the public in 2022 after years of illegal occupation.

Shri Krishna Mandir

Located in Saddar near Kabari Bazaar, Shri Krishna Mandir is the only active Hindu temple in Rawalpindi-Islamabad. Built in 1897, it holds daily prayers and celebrates major festivals like Diwali, Holi, and Janmashtami. Renovated in recent years, it serves as a spiritual center for the local Hindu community.

Bavalakh Nath Mandir

Located in the old city of Jhang, Lal Nath Mandir is a historic Hindu temple dating back to the late 19th century. Though much of it was damaged over time, especially in the 1990s, the main tower and entrance still stand. It remains open and is visited by local devotees.



Bara Mandir Chiniot

Bara Mandir is a historic Hindu temple in Chiniot, believed to date back to the 19th century. Known for its beautiful architecture blending Hindu and Sikh styles, it was once used as a girls' school. Though abandoned, it remains a significant symbol of Chiniot's multi-faith heritage.




Shaktipeeth Shri Hinglaj Mata Mandir

Shaktipeeth Shri Hinglaj Mata Mandir in Balochistan is a revered Hindu cave shrine, believed to be where Goddess Sati's head fell. Known as Nani Mandir, it draws thousands during the Hinglaj Yatra and is respected by both Hindus and local Muslims.

Goraknath Temple, Peshawar

Goraknath Temple, Peshawar, is a historic Hindu temple dedicated to Guru Goraknath, located inside the old city near Gor Khatri. Built in the 19th century, it was closed for decades after partition and later reopened following court orders. The temple holds religious significance for Hindus in the region and is one of the few active Hindu worship sites in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Shiv Mandir, Mansehra

Shiv Mandir, Mansehra, is an old Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Shiva, dating back to the pre-partition era. Once a vibrant place of worship for the local Hindu community, it now stands as a heritage site, reflecting the region's diverse religious history.
